Dear Customer:

An integral part of our Quality System includes the ability to maintain batch identity, integrity and traceability. Calumet Penreco abides by this with the following batch numbering system. Each batch number along with its product code represents a product's movement and is unique to both the product and its disposition (i.e. drums, tank truck, rail car, flexitank etc). An explanation of batch assignment follows:

Product Code: The product code is comprised of an identifier that is unique to both the product and its container.

For example: 14177 represents Drakeol 7, Bulk (tank truck, rail car etc), while 14185 represents Drakeol 7 in 55 gallon drums

In this way, the mode of disposition is apparent.

The batch number appears as, for example: K09040001

A B C D

Where **A** represents the producing facility: K = Karns City, PA
D = Dickinson, TX

B = Two numbers signifying production year: 09 = 2009; 10 = 2010

C = Two numbers signifying the production month: 04 = April, 11 = November

D = Sequential release of numbered lot for tracking purposes. This number will increment starting with batch 0001

The batch number, along with the product code, provide for both product identification and traceability. This assures our customers that all product movements are traceable and well identified in order that questions may be resolved and concerns minimized.
